The Why



Through the shared belief that every child deserves equal access to education, Wycliffe Charities has helped transform this vision into reality across Palm Beach County classrooms.

Every student deserves a classroom where opportunity isn't defined by zip code. Yet, teachers across the country continue to bridge the gap with their own wallets. According to the U.S. Department of Education, 94% of public school teachers purchase classroom supplies with no reimbursement.

Here in Palm Beach County, teachers reported spending more than \$800 out of pocket each year before gaining access to Red Apple Supplies, the Education Foundation's free teacher resource store.

Thanks to community partners like Wycliffe Charities, those same teachers now walk into their classrooms equipped with essential tools, and renewed hope. In a recent survey, **84**% of teachers said their students now learn in a more equitable environment because of the resources they receive through Red Apple Supplies.

When a teacher doesn't have to choose between buying pencils or paying bills, students thrive, and entire classrooms change.

As we reflect on this year's Backpack Initiative, we're filled with gratitude for the incredible generosity of our sponsors, donors, partners, and volunteers.

Because of Wycliffe Charities' commitment, more than **30,500** students across **48** Title I schools started the school year prepared to learn — each backpack filled with the tools and confidence needed for success.

This year's efforts were powered by over **600** volunteers, who dedicated more than **2,000** hours to make a lasting impact in our classrooms and community. Together, we're not just providing school supplies — we're opening doors to opportunity, hope, and possibility. It's more than just a backpack.




Over the Years
